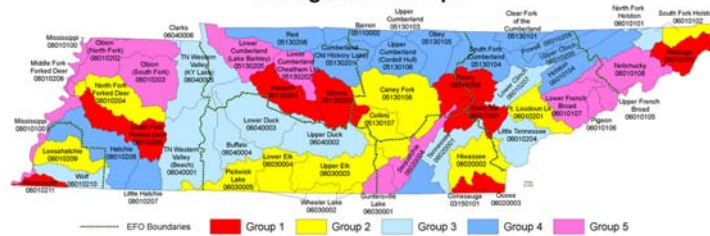

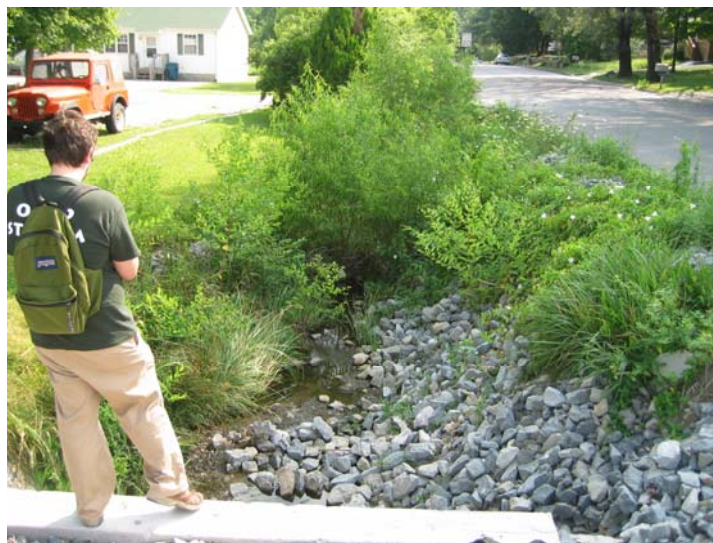
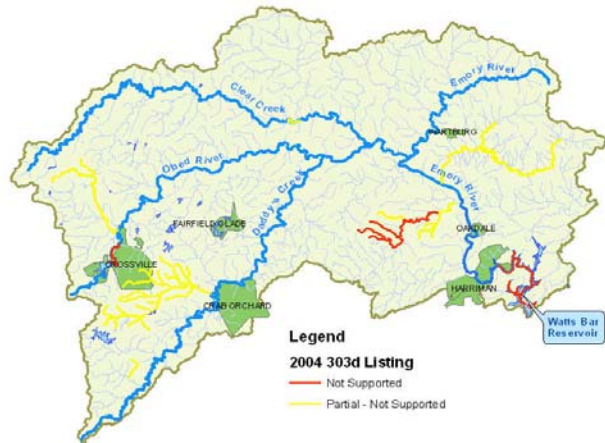
## Emory Watershed with County Boundaries

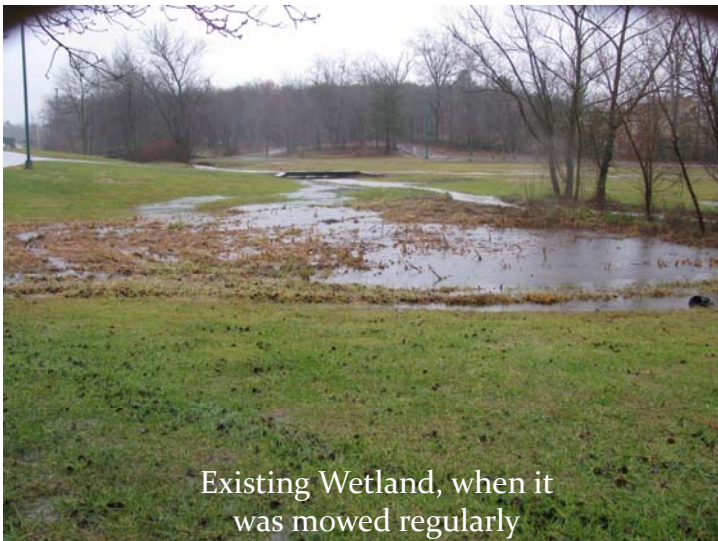
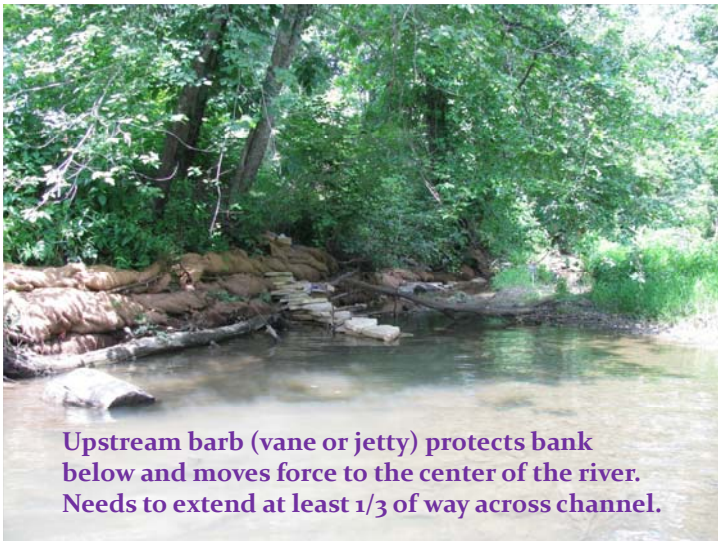

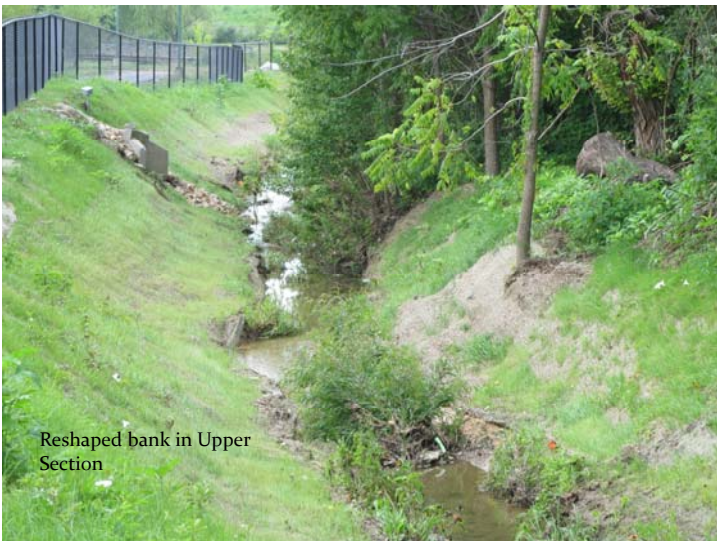
